








NATIONAL EXPO



Grand National Expo was the stellar attraction at Agrovision and was visited by lakhs of farmers from Maharashtra & other States. The expo was spread over 25000 Sq. Mtr. area. 10000 Sq. Mtr. area with 6 Doms encompassing around 350 exhibitors & 15000 Sq. Mtr. open to sky area accommodated 40 stalls. Well known corporates from agri field, related State & Central Govt. Departments, Research Institutes, Agri Universities, financial institutions exhibited their products & services in the expo. Grass root level innovators were added attraction for the visiting farmers. For the first time there was a MSME and NSIC pavilion where the ministry displayed their schemes & their members exhibited their products.

In a special animal husbandry pavilion live demo of various breeds of animals, various species of cow, bullocks, goats attracted large number of farmers.

WORKSHOPS FOR FARMERS

1. "DAIRY DEVELOPMENT & MILK PROCESSING IN VIDARBHA"

A Conference on 'Dairy Development & Milk Processing in Vidarbha' was organized with the support of NDDB on 23rd November, 2019. Hon'ble Shri.Giriraj Singh, Minister of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Govt. of India inaugurated the conference and it was presided over by Shri. Dilip Rath, IAS, Chairman, National Dairy Development Board (NDDB). The Conference was a grand success as more than 2000 delegates attended the program. These sessions were addressed by experts in the field of Dairy Management. It was a platform for discussions among top industry and R&D leaders on the various opportunities and challenges in







Dairy and the steps to overcome them. The participants learnt about production, processing, breeding & cattle management, marketing and use of dairy products and develop a broader understanding of Dairy industry and other selected areas.

Project:

Cotton Farmer Survey in Vidarbha Region:

With the objective of understanding, analysing and interpreting the adoption of BT cotton and different farm practices amongst different districts of vidarbha region of Maharashtra, Agrovision Foundation, Nagpur in collaboration with SOUTH ASIA BIOTECHNOLOGY CENTRE (SABC), New Delhi and ANKUR SEEDS Pvt Ltd, Nagpur has successfully implemented a massive Survey of cotton farmers in 5 districts of vidarbha region. It was cried out in with help of students through an objective questionnaire in local





language from several villages of the districts. This comprehensive survey of cotton farmers was conducted during the Kharif 2019 crop season, Nearly 700-800 farmers as respondents were covered to get information on the status of Bt cotton cultivation, their problems of marketing, perceptions on the currently grown unapproved HT/Bt cotton in the region and also some common issues that they confront in day-to day farming. It is clear from the survey that Bt cotton is still the preferred technology and farmers are eagerly waiting for officially approved HT/Bt cotton. It is essential for the seed companies as well as public institutions to devote their research for new better Bt hybrids of cotton and also develop rapport with Government for permission of Ht/Bt technology in cotton officially, as the illegal growing may attract the unscrupulous players in seed market to cheat the farmers in the name of new technology.

A report of the above survey was published with the title "ON FARM TECHNOLOGY ASSESSMENT AND FORSIGHT OF COTTON IN VIDARBHA REGION OF MAHARASHTRA"

Pink Bollworm Management Campaign -2019-20.



Cotton is one of the most important commercial crop of vidarbha region. In the last 2 decade it has witnessed substantial raise in productivity. However there have been few set backs to its cultivation like the outbreak of pink boll warm. Agrovision Foundation in collaboration with SABC and Rasi Seeds organised a mega event to educate farmers for the management of pink boll worm since last two years. This year in 2019-20, the campaign was carried out in major districts of vidarbha viz, Yavtmal, Amaravati, Wardha, Akola, Nagpur, Washim, Buldhana. The launch of the campaign was done from warud district Amravati at the hands of Hon. Shri Anil Bonde former Agriculture minister Govt. of Maharashtra.

Awareness was spread through distribution of posters, Cartoon booklets, moving floats, display of hoardings, Broadcasting of Jingle on Radio, Sending What's app and text SMS etc. 50,000 posters and 10,000 cartoon —booklets in Marathi on Pink Boll Worm Management with simple tips on Dos and Don'ts were prepared and circulated in Vidarbha region of Maharashtra. Finally with the help of KVK and Colleges 3 huge farmers rallies were organized. Local Media support was generated to give wide publicity to the campaign. The Report was published with the title "Scientific Outreach And farmers 'Awareness Campaign on Pink Bollworm in Kharif 2019-20"

Awareness camp for farmers were organised during Pink Bollworm campaign in Vidarbha. Posters & information Booklets were distributed to the participants.
